
It's the "Flu Season" in Cattaraugus County!

What is "the Flu?"

- Infection caused by a virus that affects nose, throat and lungs
- Affects everyone
- Can cause death
- Each year there may be different types of the same virus causing disease
- You can prevent it by getting the vaccine!





When is the Flu season?

- Starts in October and ends in May
- <u>Peak:</u> December-February
- Sometimes it is mild and at other times severe!
- Flu vaccine may not always be a perfect match, but it can protect!

Who should take the vaccine?

- ⇒ Recommended: Everyone 6 months and older
- ⇒ Talk to your doctor for what is best for your family

What are the signs of the Flu?

- * Fever/chills
- * Cough
- Sore throat
- * Runny /stuffy nose
- * Muscle/body aches
- * Headaches
- * Tiredness
- Vomiting/diarrhea (mostly in children)

Can I spread it?

- YES!
- Through Coughing, Sneezing, Talking, Touching
- You can spread the flu before you know you are sick and upto 7 days after you become sick.

How can I Prevent the Spread of the Flu?

GET THE FLU VACCINE!

- LIMIT CONTACT with sick people
- TAKE THE MEDS that your doctor gives you
- STAY HOME for at least 24h after fever is gone
- DON'T TOUCH!—your eyes, nose or mouth!
- COVER! Use tissues to cover your cough and sneeze. If you don't have tissues,
 sneeze into your upper sleeve or elbow
- WASH! Your hands with soap and water or an alcohol-based hand rub
- CLEAN IT UP! Wipe all surfaces with a disinfectant!
